From The Rectory

It's fair to say that I have felt a little bit of jealousy so far this year at some of the places which people around me have been visiting on their recent holidays – cruises through Europe and Southeast Asia, safari trips to Africa, skiing in Norway. At the same time, I have felt a little exhausted at many of the itineraries of these holidays. I'd rather just kick back, relax and do very, very little.

Rest is a wonderful thing. And as our world seems to speed up more and more, rest is both more important and harder to come by. The Bible agrees that rest is crucial to our wellbeing as humans. So much so that it pictures God as also resting from his work. And then later makes the wry comment, if God saw fit to have a day of rest every seven days, then you his mere creature should do so too.

Ignoring the need to rest has consequences – physically, mentally and even spiritually. We humans have built in limitations; we are only finite beings. If we don't stop it will catch up with us sooner or later. So God prescribes a day of rest, the Jewish Sabbath (Saturday) but in Christianity moved to Sunday.

“Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a sabbath to the LORD your God.

On it you shall not do any work...”
(Exodus 20:8-10)

Although I've just quoted the fourth of the ten commandments, this day of rest is not meant to be a burden, but a delightful gift to us. A day to stop work, not just as a 'day off' work to do all the tasks we were too busy to do on workdays, but a day of actual rest. A day to enjoy both our Creator God (in worship) and the world he has created. A day of justice – the Bible says that we should ensure that everyone has a day of rest as part of their dignity as a human made in “God's image”.

In this modern world, though, it is the massively counter-cultural act of stepping off the merry-go-round of life to catch up with ourselves. To say I am not just a worker, I am a precious being made in God's image. To find refreshment, to find peace, to find God.

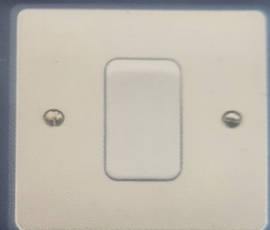

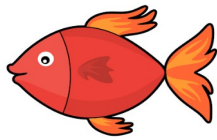

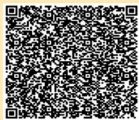

Ramblings of a North Tawton W.I. Member

It always happens around this time of year. The same old subject crops up. There are lively debates and animated discussions accompanied by grave expressions on very serious faces. And the reason for all this is down to one simple question. 'Have you tilled your seed spuds yet?' Now, according to stories passed down by our ancestors, there are several ways to check if tis time for tilling – one such suggestion is when the first dandelions appear in the fields, as apparently dandelions start to grow when the soil reaches 50 degrees farenheit, which is an ideal temperature for those potato tubers. Another involves watching out for the first yellow wagtail to appear. And my favourite [those with a sensitive nature should look away now] is for the gardener to remove his trousers and apply his bare buttocks to the soil. If it's too cold for the naked flesh then it's too cold for the spuds. I have made husband aware of this particular method. He is giving it serious consideration. Clive has had personal experience of the Project as he went on to say that, by following the guidelines, he was able to reverse his own Type 2 diabetes in eight weeks. The Freshwell website also contains information about Time Restricted Eating [otherwise known as 'intermittent fasting'] which explains the importance of

not just knowing what to eat but when to eat – there is information regarding the impact of a low carb lifestyle on cholesterol levels and it also looks at how carbs have the potential to be addictive. Clive was careful to point out that seeing your GP prior to starting any weight loss plan is always advisable. Finally – Clive had asked us to bring along a selection of packeted foods from our cupboards at home with the idea of examining the lists of ingredients to demonstrate how carbohydrates can form a large part of the processed foods that we consume – I think I already knew that my packet of custard creams was never going to be classed as a 'Superfood'.

Unfortunately Dame Anna Wintour [Vogue editor-in-chief from 1988 to 2025] has a prior engagement so will be unable to attend our May Fashion Show. Such a shame. Preparations are well underway and tickets are selling fast. The models are practising strutting the catwalk, so out of curiosity I looked up 'how should fashion models walk?' 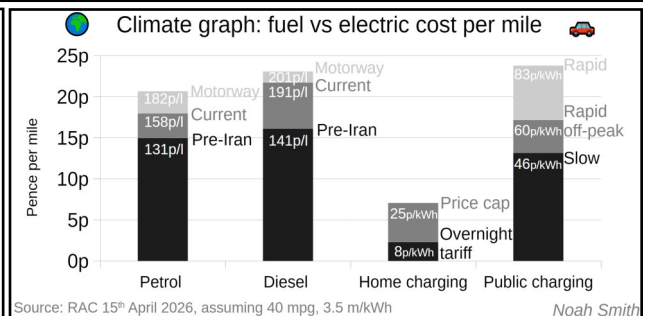

BONDLEIGH RAINFALL

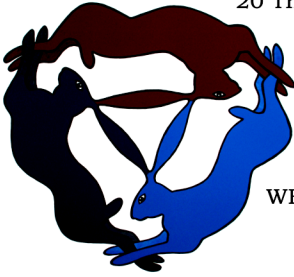

North Tawton's Emergency Plan

Here at the Town Council Office, we have spent a number of months re-writing the Town's Emergency Plan. What would we do if there was a significant flood, or a pollution incident, or another pandemic?

The Emergency Plan has been developed to provide local community resilience in the pre-event phase, or early stages of, an emergency. The plan has been finalised and will be made available to residents soon via a leaflet drop throughout the town. Each property will receive a copy of the leaflet, and the main plan itself will be used by the Community Response Team, who are all volunteers within the Council and the community. In an emergency, any plan we provide will, of course, be subject to the emergency services taking control and co-ordinating the situation. Our plan is to offer support and help to residents of North Tawton in a coherent way alongside and with instructions obtained from the emergency service teams where necessary.

The North Tawton Community Response Team will assist both the activation of the plan and the emergency responders, wherever possible, prior to, during and after an emergency. The aim of this plan is to increase community resilience through developing a robust coordinated approach that complements the work of emergency responders.

The objectives of this plan are to:

- Identify risks to the community.
- Identify strategies to reduce and respond to an emergency, including warning the community.
- Identify vulnerable people within the community.
- Identify community resources available during an emergency.
- Provide contact details for the Community Response Team, community resources, the emergency services and local authorities.
- Provide information and assistance to the emergency services when they arrive and throughout the event.

If you would like to offer to help in an emergency situation, please contact the Town Clerk or Deputy Clerk on the details below. We would appreciate the help of any medical professionals, teachers, animal care workers, mechanics, and anyone with a skill that might be of use should the circumstances arise. This will be of great service to the community.

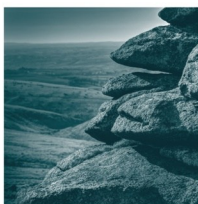
